To be SAFE at all times I...

- *follow teacher instructions*
- *use kind words, body language and tone*
- *tell the teacher if there is a problem*

To be SAFE inside the classroom or when learning I...

- always enter and remain with the teacher
- walk at all times
- keep my hands and feet to myself
- am aware of the space and equipment around me
- use all equipment for its purpose
- only leave the space with teacher permission
- follow cyber safety rules
- ask permission to enter the office

To be SAFE outside or when on the playground I...

- am aware of space and others around me
- exit the school with a teacher (during school time)
- play non contact games only
- place my bag neatly in my class lines in the morning
- play tip/running games on the grass areas only
- play where the teacher is on duty
- sit down on the silver seats or a step when eating or drinking
- sit on the bus at all times
- sit on the silver seats near the hall until the 8.55am bell
- use half court when playing basketball only
- use small balls for play on the asphalt in the morning
- walk back to class lines at the end of break times
- walk in the walkways
- wash my hands after using the toilet
- wear a hat at all times

To be RESPECTFUL outside or when on the playground I...

- allow others to learn
- ask to use others belongings
- give positive or constructive feedback
- include others in group discussions
- listen
- mind my own business
- place rubbish in the correct bin
- put items back in the correct place after use
- share school equipment
- sing the National Anthem and school song with pride
- take turns
- use whole body listening (5 L's)
- wait my turn

- be aware of others

- be a problem solver
- give positive and constructive feedback
- reflect on learning intentions
- remember passwords and logins/technology card
- try my best
- use feedback to grow
- use whole body listening (5 L's)
- watch others if I am unsure how to do something
- work towards and reflect on my goals

To be a LEARNER outside or when on the playground I...

- ask to join groups and games
- be on time to lines after breaks
- have my Opal card ready when catching the bus
- know how to catch the bus
- know what games I can play and what equipment I can use
- learn the rules of new games
- play by the agreed rules
- tell a teacher on duty as soon as there is a problem
- use the toilet and bubblers only when necessary and for its purpose
- watch others if I am unsure how to play a game
